Climate

Average Temperature

Grenfell and the surrounding district have varied seasonal weather.

The coldest month is January with an average temperature of -16° C. The warmest month is July with a heat level that shows an average of 18.7° C. Grenfell and area has an average of 2414 sun hours in the year and an annual average rainfall of 265.20 mm or 10.4 inches. The weather is excellent for livestock and speciality crops, and the area is in the heart of the highest flax producing area in North America.

Law Enforcement

¹The RCMP's mandate, as outlined in section 18 of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Act, is multi-faceted. It includes preventing and investigating crime; maintaining peace and order; enforcing laws; contributing to national security; ensuring the safety of state officials, visiting dignitaries and foreign missions; and providing vital operational support services to other police and law enforcement agencies within Canada and abroad.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police is the Canadian national police service and an agency of the Ministry of Public Safety Canada.

The RCMP is unique in the world since it is a national, federal, provincial and municipal policing body. We provide a total federal policing service to all Canadians and policing services under contract to the three territories, eight provinces (except Ontario and Quebec), more than 150 municipalities, more than 600 Aboriginal communities and three international airports.

²Canadians often see RCMP police officers wearing their dress uniform, the red serge, at functions and events. Officers traditionally wear this uniform during Royal tours, official visits of foreign dignitaries, Canada Day and to honor those who have served.

Police officers proudly represent the RCMP and Canada at many ceremonial events, functions and speaking engagements – often above and beyond their regular daily duty.

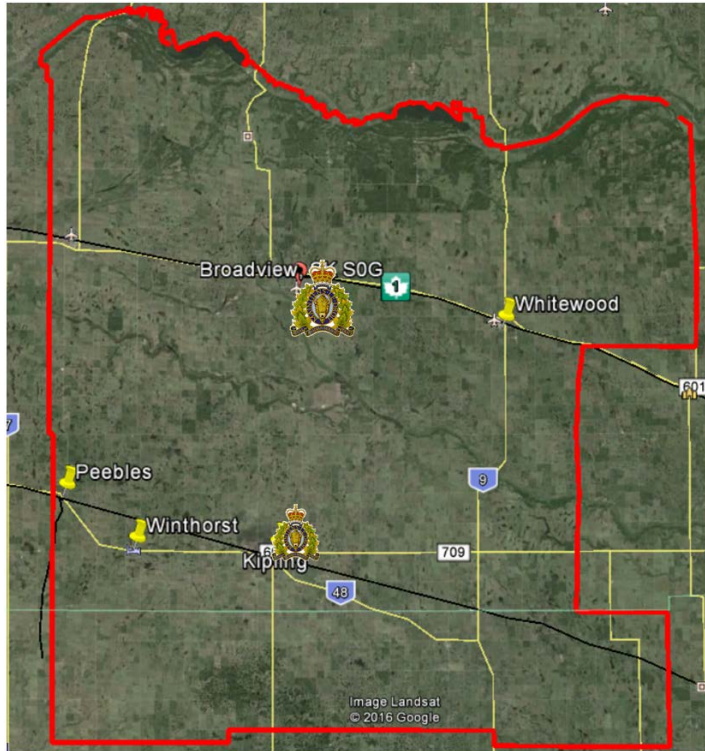

The Broadview Detachment of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police which serves Grenfell has two locations, the main office in Broadview and a sub office is located to the south in Kipling.

On average there are 10 officers, including the Staff Sargent, stationed in the Broadview detachment and 3 stationed out of the Kipling office. The Traffic Services Unit as of 2016 had 4 members which may be increased over time.

Fire Protection/Emergency Response

The Grenfell Fire Department consists of 20 volunteer fire fighters.

Fire Chief Dwayne Stone, Deputy Fire Chief Mike Kardash and three Assistant Fire Chiefs lead a core of 15 volunteer fire fighters in the Grenfell Fire Department.

Fire Equipment

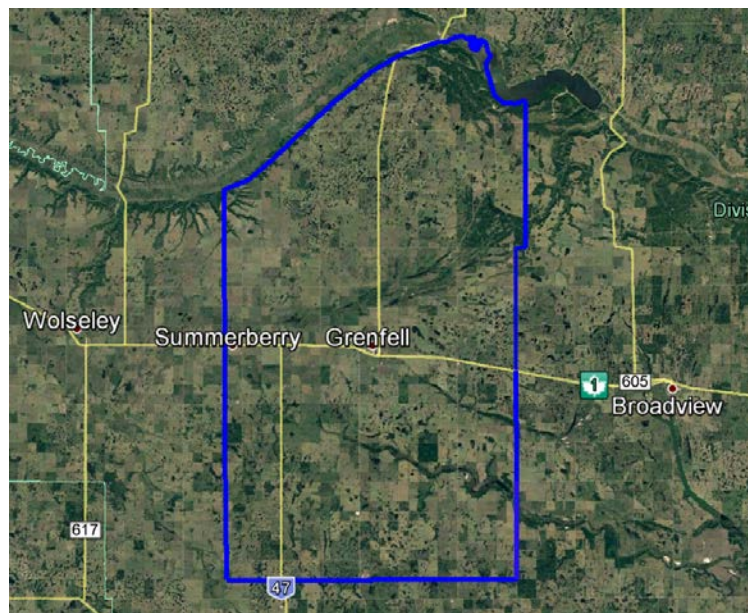
The Fire Department is equipped with the following:

1990 Ford F800 gas, (Rural Truck) Pumper#1, carries 1,400 gallons of water
 1990 Ford F800 Crew Cab, diesel Pumper #2, carries 700 gallons, set up for auto ex and vehicles fires, also carries main set of Jaws of Life, SCBAs, and blocking, etc.
 1997 Ford F450 XLT Super Duty, Command Unit, diesel, carries SCBAs, water packs, second set of Jaws of Life, blocking, highway signs, communication radios/lights.
 1987 GMC Crewcab, 314 ton, gas. Used for rural wildland fires, carries 250 gallons of water and foam, tools, extra hoses.
 2016 John Deere Gator, gas, four up, carries 60 gallons of water, water back packs, foam, leaf blower, tools.

Area Served

Grenfell Fire Department covers a geographic area from Summerberry to the West, Oakshella Saskatchewan to the East, 12 miles south of Grenfell and the Qu'Appelle Valley to the north.

Grenfell has Mutual Aid agreement with Broadview, Whitewood and Kipling to ensure fire coverage at all times.

The department meets monthly and ensures the provision of training on an ongoing basis.
